Dear Applicant:

The Application Criteria listed below serves as a guide to assist you in preparing a thorough and complete application for the NASP/NAEOP Emerging Leaders Institute. The criteria will also help you to determine your readiness to engage in the NASP/NAEOP Emerging Leaders Institute.

- 1) Applicants and nominators must be current members of NASP/NAEOP. The committee will only review forms of those applicants who are members in good standing.
- 2) If selected, applicants must maintain tenure of paid membership in NASP/NAEOP.
- 3) A minimum of two years experience working in your current TRIO position is required for all applicants.
- 4) If selected, applicants are expected to assume a future leadership role in NASP/NAEOP and/or their state chapter after they complete the Emerging Leaders Institute.
- 5) If selected, applicants are expected to be present at ELI trainings, and to complete their assigned project in the time designated by the ELI Trainer(s).
- 6) Preference will be given to applicants who have demonstrated prior volunteer and/or leadership experiences (including opportunities outside TRIO).
- 7) Applicants should comment on their attendance/presentations at professional conferences and workshops, both inside and outside TRIO, and experiences working with disadvantaged individuals.
- 8) **Submit a completed application** including all required documents to the corresponding State President (or his/her designee) by **5:00 p.m., August 19, 2011**. All applications will be received and thoroughly reviewed by your State President (or his/her designee). The State President can submit up to four applications to the NASP/NAEOP ELI Selection Committee for consideration. Based on the strength of the materials contained in the application packet, the NASP/NAEOP ELI Selection Committee will recommend four (4) candidates from each state to enroll in the Emerging Leaders Institute for the following year.
